1. The Region 5 Championships gives athletes an opportunity to compete against other athletes from around the region

2. The Region 5 Championships is an Elite Mobility competition

3. The Region 5 Championships is a qualifying competition to Stars & Stripes Championships, as well as the USA Gymnastics National Championships

4. The Region 5 Championships is a preparation competition for national and international competitions

Entry Deadline: March 8, 2024

All entries should be submitted on the USA Gymnastics Reservation System Entries received after the deadline will be doubled. NO EXCEPTIONS.

After March 8, information may be changed or corrected for no charge until March 31 on the USA Gymnastics Reservation System. Starting on April 1, information may be changed or corrected for \$10 per change. If an age or gender is listed incorrectly there will be a \$10 charge per event starting on April 1. Changes made after April 13 or onsite will have a charge of \$25. Changes from April 1-13 should be sent to region5tnt@gmail.com or completed through the Google Form at tinyurl.com/region5changes

Competition Divisions:

Individual Trampoline, Synchronized Trampoline (Levels 9 & Above), Tumbling, Double-Mini Trampoline, HUGS

Rules:

USA Gymnastics Trampoline and Tumbling rules for the current Code of Points along with all errata pages and the Rules and Policies (posted on usagym.org) will be used. For events where three judges are used, the total scores will be averaged and multiplied times two to determine the execution score. Please note that there will be no finals. All age groups are based on the age of the competitor on December 31, 2024.

Team Competition:

Team awards will be given on each discipline (trampoline, tumbling, double-mini). The top 5 scores per gym will be added together to determine a team total (only athletes Level 8&up will count towards the team total). The team with the highest combined score will be awarded as the 2024 Region 5 Champion for that discipline.

Eligible: Currently registered USA Gymnastics T&T athletes Level 1-Elite.

Coaches: Coaches must have an active USA Gymnastics Coaches Membership.

 Coaches must meet all USA Gymnastics Coaches Membership Requirements and must register on the official entry form.

Judges

To be considered for assignment judges MUST:

- 1. Submit a request using the form below by the deadline
- 2. Have an active USA Gymnastics Judges Membership
- 3. Have a rating as designated by the USA Gymnastics Technical Committee
- 4. Have completed the T210 Annual Update.

Panels will be seated based on rating and experience, but no one will be considered without submitting the form below.
